Year 3 Orientation

Orientation and Training 3 days

Family Medicine Clerkship	7 weeks
Medicine (Inpatient) Clerkship	8 weeks

Surgery Clerkship	4 + 4 weeks
OB/GYN & Women's Health	7 weeks
