Biomarkers in CSv2

Biomarkers that are NAACCR-standard data items are collected through site-specific factors (SSF) of Collaborative Stage version 2 (CSv2)

- Colon and Rectum
 - SSF7: Micro-satellite instability
 - SSF9: KRAS
 - SSF10: 18q Loss of Herozygosity
 - SSF11: Mitotic count
- Hematopoietic, reticuloendothelial, immunoproliferative, myeloproliferative, or myelodysplastic disease
 - SSF1: JAK-2

Biomarkers in CSv2, cont.

Breast

SSF8 & SSF9: HER2: IHC

SSF10 & SSF11: HER2: FISH

SSF12 & SSF13: HER2: CISH

• SSF14: HER2: Other

SSF15: HER2: Summary Result of Testing

• SSF16: Combinations of ER, PR, & HER2

Ssf22 & SSF23 Multigene Signature

Comorbidities and Complications

- The NAACCR record allows the recording of up to 10 comorbid conditions, factors influencing the health status of the patient, and treatment complications. All are considered secondary diagnoses.
- Effective with cases diagnosed January 1, 2010, the recording of Comorbidities and Complications is required by NHSCR.
- Note: The data item Source Comorbidity is for Central Registry use only
- Coding:
 - Information is recorded using the International Classification of Disease commonly known as ICD-9 or ICD-10.
 - When coding the comorbidities and/or complications please do not combine the use of ICD-9 and ICD-10. Use one or the other.
 - ICD-10 is expected to be implemented in year 2011.
 - Refer to the NHSCR Data Collection Manual

Other NAACCR Standard Data Items

- Effective diagnosis year 2011, NHSCR requires the coding of AJCC <u>Clinical</u> TNM and stage group for two sites only:
 - Breast
 - Rectum
- TEXT: Please substantiate every code that is entered into an abstract, especially those related to treatment:
 - Chemo
 - Hormone
 - BRM
 - Other
